

ARTICLE III: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1: Composition of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors is comprised of the President, the President-elect, Past President, Secretary, Treasurer, Diversity and Conference Climate Committee Chair, three (3) Members-at-Large and two (2) Graduate Student Representatives, all of whom shall serve as voting members of the Board of Directors. The Editor of the Sociology of Sport Journal, Editor of Engaging Sports, Archivist, Chair of the Communications Committee, an Administrator of the listserv, Chair of the Environmental Impact Committee, Conference Director, Conference Locator, Membership Liaison, Parliamentarian, and Chair of SEEDS Committee shall be ex-officio, non-voting members of the Board, who are appointed by the Board for a three-year term.

Article VI: Committees

Section 14: Scholars Enlightened and Engaged in Disrupting Structures Program Committee

At each annual meeting of the Society, the Board of Directors shall recognize and appoint a SEEDS Committee.

The Scholars Enlightened and Engaged in Disrupting Structures (SEEDS) Program reflects NASSS' values through the coordination of an annual conference workshop aimed at establishing and sustaining a supportive community of sport studies scholars. SEEDS offers mentoring and professional development experiences for Black, Indigenous, and People of Color and historically marginalized and racialized graduate students and early career scholars in sport studies. Through the annual conference workshop and professional development sessions, and scholar-mentor engagement, SEEDS strives to recognize and address missed opportunities in the mentorship and development of historically marginalized and racialized people. SEEDS is a program that challenges colonial, sexist, racist, and ableist prescriptions of predominantly white academic spaces. The committee shall consist of at least seven members, including the chairperson. The chairperson shall be responsible for organizing and implementing the workshop and other committee activities. To the extent that the committee organizes and delivers activities at any meeting or conference of the society, the chair shall liaise with the NASSS Conference Director, President, President-elect, and Treasurer. The SEEDS chair shall serve as an *ex officio* member of the Board. Except for the Chair, if any committee member is unable to complete a term, the SEEDS Chairperson shall appoint a replacement. If the SEEDS chair is unable to complete their term, the President shall appoint a replacement.

Article XIV: Compensation

Officers and directors of this Society and members of its committees shall serve without compensation. Traveling and maintenance expenses that they incur solely on account of this Society may be partially or wholly reimbursed at the discretion of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may in its discretion pay an honorarium to speakers at its meetings, including workshops.
